We are delighted to inform you of the upcoming Training of Trainers (TOT1), on March 13-16, 2020 in San Diego, California, to be held at Faith Chapel Church in Spring Valley. If you have attended a Vision Seminar or have discovered that the Community Health Evangelism (CHE) principles would be beneficial to your ministry, then you are a potential participant for this training.

This phase of training is aimed at understanding the Biblical basis for CHE and basic principles of wholistic community-based development. Participants learn steps for implementing CHE, how to choose a target community, and strategies for entering the community. Participants learn basic skills for raising awareness, organizing and mobilizing the community for cooperative action through the information of a development committee.

The cost of the training is \$165 which includes snacks, water, lunch and materials. Lodging is not provided. The schedule will be 8:00-5:00, with a 10-minute morning and afternoon break and a 45-minute break for lunch.
